Our Venue

The Grange Banqueting Suite is a large Manor House set in a secluded wooded surround, with ample parking space, and less than two miles from the centre of Derby.

The Grange was originally built in 1825 by John Harrison, who subsequently became the High Sheriff of Derbyshire. Later it passed to the Eastwood family who lived there until 1938. At the outbreak of the second world war it was bought by Rolls Royce for use as a training establishment.

Today the Manor House is beautifully decorated throughout and comprises of two function suites with two bar areas. Ideal for weddings, conferences and special occasions.

Our Weddings

The Grange is licensed for Civil Ceremonies providing a modern alternative to the formal Church or Registry Office proceedings. We have two dining rooms both with dance floors, together with several Wedding Chapels. The front of the house is a wonderful location for photography, with a large terrace and steps leading down to a spacious lawn. The garden is also an ideal location for your guests to enjoy a welcome drink. The main dining area can accommodate up to 150 guests for a served meal or an even larger number for a finger buffet. You have exclusive use of the ground floor facilities and grounds as we only have one wedding function at any one time.

Your wedding breakfast will be one of the highlights of your day and we promise to make it a delightful experience in every way.

The Grange is ideally situated for a conference or event, being close to the centre of Derby and less than three miles from both the A38 and A50.

We are fully licensed and our modern kitchen is able to cater for the most discerning tastes.
